### **Departures and Arrivals:**

Departure- Leave FUPC— Saturday, July 9, 2010 at 2:00pm  
Return- Arrive FUPC— Saturday, July 16, 2010 at 3:00pm

### **Objectives:**

Christ will change the way we view the world and those in need.  
To serve Christ by serving His children living in St Louis.  
Minister to and with the children we tutor, homeowners we serve, and children at backyard Bible clubs in order to be “Christ incarnate” to them during the week we serve in St Louis.  
Minister alongside another youth from Catalyst and approximately 50 to 60 other youth from around the nation.  
Further develop maturity in Christ at nightly all-group times of worship, Bible teaching time, Catalyst small group time, and prayer.

### **Cost:**

\$70 (by January 12) will reserve your spot (or save your place on the waiting list)  
The final two payments of \$70 will be due March 2, and May 4, 2011  
All other funds will be received through fundraising. Any amount short will be paid by the participant out-of-pocket.  
Scholarships (in the total or partial amount) are also available upon request.  
Make checks payable to First United Presbyterian Church  
The \$210 may be paid all at once, but no later than the above dates.

### **Number attending:**

The number will be determined by those ready to serve Christ on a mission trip (I currently have 15 spots reserved).  
Adult leadership will be determined by the number of youth attending.

### **Other important information:**

Fundraising is a very important aspect of the mission trip. The total amount raised for each fundraiser will be divided equally between those that participated in the fundraiser. So, if you don't attend a given fundraiser you will not receive any of the funds.  
The amount you still need at the end of the fundraisers will come out of your (or your parents) pocket.  
Youth missions trips are a privilege and not a right. They are for those that know Christ and are growing in maturity in Christ.  
It is a time to serve Christ and be Christ to the least of these.

### **Overnight stays:**

Due to the close proximity of St Louis, we will not be staying overnight on the way down or back.

### **Permission slips/release forms/conduct forms and turning in of money information**

The remaining pages are the FUPC permission slip, conduct form, and application. These three forms, along with \$70 to secure your spot (on the trip or on the waiting list— whichever comes first), need to be fully completed and returned to me no later than Wednesday, January 12, 2011. The last sheet in the packet is the information about important dates. This sheet is for you to post someone in your home so you remember the upcoming activities and due dates.

## ST LOUIS 2011 MISSION TRIP APPLICATION

Please type your answers to the following questions on a separate sheet of paper and return it with \$70 to Isaac no later than January 12, 2011.

Do you attend at least four Catalyst-sponsored activities per month? How has your faith grown by actively participating in these?

What are your three strengths and three weaknesses and explain how each one could:

- A. Contribute to a successful team dynamic
- B. Take away from a successful team dynamic

Please share how you came to know Jesus as your Savior and Lord.

Please share what you would say to lead someone to Christ as Savior and Lord.

We will be doing many different ministries on this trip. Tutoring, housing repairs, and backyard Bible clubs, are just a few of the things we will be doing each day. Suppose you find out you do not really enjoy tutoring (or another activity). How do you plan on turning this from a negative to a positive for yourself, your team, and to those with whom you will be ministering?

How do you plan on continuing service-evangelism upon returning from St Louis? If you went on last year's mission trip, how have you been serving since your return?

How do your parents feel about you going on this trip?

Discuss Philippians 2:1-11 and how you live out Christ's characteristics in your daily living? How does this passage help you know what priorities you must model as we prepare for and serve at this summer's mission trip? How does servant leadership play into this?

Why do you want to go on this year's mission trip? Please include your key expectations, goals, and fears for the trip.

For those that have attended the Pittsburgh Project or served in Moldova, how has the way you live today changed as a result of going on the missions trip in the past? What has been your greatest challenge while at Pittsburgh and/or Moldova and how has that experience helped your faith to grow?

When in a group, what role do you think you play (leader, cheerleader, just part of the group, idea person, pray-er, or another function as you decide)? How do you see your role being a benefit to our missions team this summer?

The mission trip is not just the week we are in St Louis, but is also in all the events (fundraising, fellowships, retreat, etc) prior to departing for St Louis. On a scale of 1 (don't plan on it) to 10 (I'm totally there), how committed are you to actively participating, and being on time, in all the events surrounding the trip?

## 2011 MISSION TRIP POLICIES FORM

*I realize that I am a  
Representative and Ambassador  
of Christ and our Church  
and need to act in an  
Appropriate Manner at all times!*

- 1) I will mutually respect the others in the group as well as the decisions made by all those in authority.  
Rationale: I Corinthians 13:4, Galatians 5:22, Ephesians 4:32, Colossians 3:12, Titus 3:1, Romans 13, I Thessalonians 5:12-13
  
- 2) I will have my application, mission trip permission slip, and mission trip policies filled out, turned into Isaac no later than January 12, 2011.
  
- 3) I will have \$70 turned into Isaac no later than January 12, 2011 (unless I talk to Isaac and make arrangements for the \$70 to be turned in at a later date).
  
- 4) I will choose to wear appropriate clothing at all times on the mission trip. That means I will refrain from wearing tank tops for men or women, halter tops for the women, tight-fitting clothing for men and women, inappropriate shorts, no shirts advertising alcohol, drugs, or sex. If I wear clothing deemed inappropriate by the adult leaders on the mission trip I will make the appropriate clothing change.
