I will mutually respect the others in the group as well as the decisions made by those in authority. That includes the youth director's decision to cancel events due to inclement weather or any other reason.

Rationale: I Corinthians 13:4, Galatians 5:22, Ephesians 4:32, Colossians 3:12, Titus 3:1, Romans 13, I Thessalonians 5:12-13

I will have a permission slip filled out, signed by a parent, and on file before I am able to attend any youth event that is off church property. This also includes any friends that come on an event off church property.

I will wear appropriate clothing at all times to youth group and its activities. That means I will refrain from wearing tank tops for men or women, halter tops for the women, spaghetti straps, tight-fitting clothing for men and women, appropriate shorts, no shirts advertising alcohol, drugs, or sex. We need to be tasteful and appropriate in all areas of our lives, even our clothing.
Rationale: Leviticus 11:44, Romans 6:12-14, I Corinthians 6:20, Ephesians 1:4, Philippians 2:14-15, I Peter 1:15-16, I Peter 5:1-5

I understand that if I violate these policies that I may:

- A. Have to call my parents and have them come and pick me up.
 - B. Not be able to participate in a given or future activity
- Rationale: Genesis 3:14-19, Leviticus 26:14-32, Deuteronomy 27:15-26
